Next Week's Liturgical Readings

January 17, 2021 – Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

- 1) 1 Samuel 3:3b-10, 19
- 2) 1 Corinthians 6:13c-15a, 17-20
- 3) John 1:35-42 Matthew 2:1-12

FOCUS: In both our first reading and the Gospel, we hear how God calls people to serve.

The young Samuel hears God's voice but does not recognize it at first. But God keeps calling and with Eli's help, Samuel is finally able to hear God's word. The disciples of John the Baptist follow Jesus at his invitation, and bring along Simon Peter: We often come to serve the Lord through the invitation of others. We can offer that same invitation to those who have not yet heard the Gospel message.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

The Lord keeps calling Samuel, who does not answer him, until Eli advises how to respond the next time he hears the Lord. Samuel is to say, *Speak, Lord, your servant is listening*. St. Paul writes the Corinthians, telling them that their bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit and they ought to glorify God in their body. In the Gospel, John the Baptist sees Jesus and declares him to be the Lamb of God. Andrew leaves John to follow Jesus, and brings his brother Simon Peter.
