This Week's Liturgical Readings

March 21, 2021 – Fifth Sunday of Lent

FOCUS: We follow and serve with hearts remade in Christ.

To make us his people and show us his love, God established a covenant with us. Christ came to usher in a new covenant - one that would reconcile us to God and draw all people to himself. With hearts remade, we follow and serve him.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading, the Lord announces *a new covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Judah*. The Letter to the Hebrews speaks of Jesus as the *source of eternal salvation for all who obey him*. In the Gospel, Jesus tells Andrew and Philip that the time has come for the Son of Man to be glorified. And that those who serve him must follow him.
