This Sunday's Liturgical Readings

April 4, 2021 – Easter

- 1) Acts 10:34a, 37-43
- 2) Colossians 3:1-4 or 1 Corinthians 5:6b-8
- 3) John 20:1-9 or Mark 16:1-7

FOCUS: Together with the Church throughout the world, we celebrate Christ's resurrection from the dead.

Jesus is risen from the dead; he appeared to his disciples. His rising to new life foreshadows what God intends for us: eternal life. The darkness of sin and death has been defeated by the Light of Christ, who died for us. Together, let us sing our praise to God. Alleluia!

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading, St. Peter speaks to the crowd, telling them of all that he witnessed in the ministry and execution of Jesus Christ. He proclaims the Good News that everyone *who believes in [Jesus Christ] will receive forgiveness of sins through his name*. St. Paul tells the Corinthians that Christ is *our paschal lamb (who)...has been sacrificed*. In the Gospel, the disciples encounter the empty tomb of Jesus.
