This Week's Liturgical Readings

June 27, 2021 – 13th Sunday in Ordinary Time

- 1) Wisdom 1:13-15, 2:23-24
- 2) 2 Corinthians 8:7, 9, 13-15
- 3) Mark 5:21-43

FOCUS: Generosity and love come from God, and are at the heart of being a disciple.

In the 2nd reading, St Paul encourages the Church at Corinth to be generous in their giving. With the knowledge that our God loves us unconditionally and generously, we can, in turn, model generosity of love and service to others with the grace given to us at our baptism.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

The author of Wisdom rejects the idea that death was God's creation; rather, it was brought into the world *by the envy of the devil*. Paul exhorts the community at Corinth to be generous, and to share out of their abundance with those less fortunate. In the Gospel, Jesus heals Jairus' daughter and a woman who had been hemorrhaging for 12 years.
