

Music Selections for Weddings

For a Wedding Mass, there are typically four music selections: the Processional hymn (sometimes one for the wedding party, another for the bride), the hymn for the Presentation of the Gifts, the Communion Hymn and the Recessional (closing). Specific Prelude music may also be requested. Secular and recorded music are not permitted.

Prelude/Processional Music
