Dear Parents,

It was good to see so many of our parents take advantage of this day to pick up any school books and at home learning packets. As a reminder, learning packets are **mandatory** for all 2nd through 7th grade students. Packets will be available on the website and in the school office on Mondays and they are due back the following Monday except for Middle School. Middle School student due dates vary by teacher. These can be found in the directions given by each teacher. Teachers will post grades by Wednesday of each week.

Again, I strongly recommend that you take advantage of all of the materials and resources we have made available for our younger students from PreK through 1st grade. These too can be found on our website or in the school office.

Beginning tomorrow, our cafeteria will be serving “Grab N Go” lunches from the entrance to the cafeteria. They will be served to **any** child 18 years or younger. Your child must be present with you. They will receive a lunch and a breakfast for the next day. These will be served from 10:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m.

As a reminder, the school office will be open on Mondays from 9:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. and then from 4:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m. The office will reopen on Wednesdays from 9:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. If you need to reach any of us outside of these hours, you can do so via email. If you need any of our email addresses, they can be found on the school website. All faculty will be checking their emails Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. and then again from 1:00 p.m. until 3:00 p.m. Office staff will be checking consistently throughout the day.

We are in the process of updating our website with an “At Home Learning” tab. Under this tab, you can locate all at home learning packets as well as announcements from the Office of Catholic Schools, messages from myself, and other information pertaining to this health pandemic. This tab will be completed by 11:00 a.m. tomorrow.

Tomorrow we will be emailing you your child’s 3rd quarter report card. If you do not receive one, please contact the school office.

Lastly, it is very important that you keep your email information updated with the school office. Email will be the main form of communication during this school closure period; therefore, it is imperative that we have your correct email address. A text is always sent prior to the email stating for you to check your email. If you get the text but no email, the text will have instructions on how to notify us of your updated email.

I will continue to pray for all of our families during this time.
