## ***A WORD FROM FR. JOHN...***

With some sadness, I share with you another transition in our community. **Ivan Bosnar**, our Associate Director of Music, serving primarily at St. Boniface and St. Mary's, as an organist and choir leader, has applied for and accepted the position of Director of Music for St. John the Evangelist Church in Spencerport. As he indicated in his email informing me of the change, "St. Boniface position was my first job in the United States, and it helped me greatly during my Masters studies at Eastman. I have learned a lot there and the knowledge gained there is a treasure that I will keep. Over the previous academic year the position extended to St. Mary's, for which I am also very thankful as there I have learned even more, considering the differences in the music tradition of the two churches. Now I think it is time to gain another experience and skills of being a Music Director in another setting." Those who have experienced his exceptional musical talents and kind personality appreciate all that Ivan has shared with us. We are in the process of filling the position and hope to have someone in place soon. Ivan's last weekend in our parish churches will be July 21 & 22. Please join me in wishing him well in his new position and in his continued Ph.D. studies at the Eastman School of Music.

At our Masses this weekend, we are hearing from Sr. Lorraine Burns and Sr. Evelyn Breslin, from the School Sisters of Notre Dame, as part of our **Summer Mission Appeal**. They are sharing with us something about their ministry and missionary work on behalf of the larger Church. In many ways, they are continuing the work that the disciples were sent off to do by Jesus in our gospel today. Like the disciples, who were instructed not to take many things with them, they endeavor to make the good news of Jesus Christ what they carry and share with others. While we may not be a part of a formal missionary program, we too are invited to carry the good news of Jesus Christ out into our community through how we live our daily lives. We do that through the corporal and spiritual works of mercy that we perform inspired and empowered by the Holy Spirit and our love of Christ. These works of mercy need not be performed as part of an explicit church ministry or charity. Parents and those who care for others involve themselves in feeding the hungry, offering clothing and shelter, tending to the sick, offering counseling, instruction, comfort, forgiving wrongs and bearing patiently with others. In addition to these efforts which support and further the mission that Jesus gave us, we have an opportunity to join in the missionary work of the sisters through our contributions to the second collection taken up on their behalf. Thank you for your generous support of their mission and ministry, as well as all the good work you do that may go unacknowledged, but is no less important in terms of revealing of the kingdom of God in our midst.

A few weeks ago, I encouraged you to carve out some time for the Sabbath rest that allows us to relax and be re-created. One of those opportunities is coming up next Sunday at our **All Parish Summer Social Pulled Pork Picnic Lunch**. Your last chance to purchase a ticket was after Masses this weekend. I look forward to joining those who did next Sunday, July 22, from 12:00 to 2:00 PM in the Dugan Center and gardens at St. Mary's. In addition to the good food, I am sure there will be plenty of fun and fellowship to share.

Sr. Kathleen informed me this week that our **Vacation Bible Camp**, scheduled for the final week of this month (July 23-27) is full and we are not accepting anymore registrations. This is a surprising turn of events, as just a few weeks ago, she indicated that the sign-ups were running well behind the previous years' totals. With all these children joining us, I am grateful for all those who took tags from church for various supplies that are needed. If you have not already, please bring those to church and drop them in the VBC containers in the back of all three churches no later than next weekend, July 21/22. We appreciate your generous support that will help to make for a fun and faith-filled week for our children.

One last note: I am happy and thankful for the rescue of the twelve soccer players and their coach from the cave in Thailand. It was wonderful to see people from many countries come together to support and make the rescue effort happen in such treacherous conditions. Would that we could be inspired to come together more readily cooperating to overcome any number of challenges that we face in our neighborhoods, community, state, nation and world. I pray for the repose of the soul of the one diver who lost his life in the rescue effort and for his family and friends who mourn his loss. And may God bless all those involved in this miraculous rescue effort and similar efforts that don't get as much media attention, but nonetheless are worthy of thanks and praise.

## RENEWING AND REFRESHING ADULT FAITH

Each week for the summer, a parishioner will reflect on a section of Pope Francis' *Call to Holiness: his new Apostolic Exhortation Gaudete et Exsultate (Rejoice and Be Glad)*,

Subtle Enemies of Holiness: Pelagianism

In responding to the universal call to holiness, Pope Francis in *Gaudete et Exsultate (Rejoice and Be Glad)* warns us of two pitfalls: gnosticism and pelagianism. Reflecting on the former last week, I now turn to the latter. When we fall prey to pelagianism, we conceive ourselves as radically autonomous individuals who are capable of saving ourselves, without recognizing that, at the deepest level of being, we derive from God and from others. As such, salvation depends on the strength of the individual or on purely human structures, which are incapable of welcoming the newness of the Spirit of God.

In reality, however, only a heartfelt and prayerful acknowledgement of our limitations allows grace to work within us to bring about the good that is part of our transformational journey of faith. As Pope Francis states, "Unless we can acknowledge our concrete and limited situation, we will not be able to see the real and possible steps that the Lord demands of us at every moment, once we are attracted and empowered by his gift" (no.50). This can be detrimental to the life of the church: "Once we believe that everything depends on human effort as channeled by ecclesial rules and structures, we unconsciously complicate the Gospel and become enslaved to a blueprint that leaves few openings for the working of grace" (no.59).

As a corrective, Pope Francis calls us to let ourselves be led by the Spirit in the way of love, and to be passionate about communicating the beauty and joy of the Gospel and seeking out the lost among the immense crowds that thirst for Christ (no.57). Holding to the greatest commandment, we seek the face of God reflected in the face of so many others whom we love as ourselves. Lastly, Pope Francis invites us to reflect and discern before God whether either pelagian or gnostic aberrations might be present in our lives.

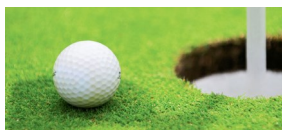


**ALL PARISH
