Language Arts

This month we will focus on:

- ✓ Comprehension: cause and effect, character, setting, plot, sequence, problem and solution
- ✓ Handwriting and phonics: Uu, Vv, Ww, Xx, Yy, Jj, Qq /qu/, Yy, and Zz
- ✓ Writing complete sentences
