RELIGION

The children will learn about the bible stories of Adam and Eve, Noah, Joseph, Moses, David and Goliath, Daniel and many others.

LANGUAGE ARTS The following skills will be taught in the month of April:

- Phonics - Yy Zz, long a_e words, long i_i_e words
- Handwriting - Yy Zz writing sentences
- High frequency words: this, what, help, too has, play
- Continuing to blend words to read words and distinguishing sounds heard in words.

MATH

We will continue to practice number identification by using the hundreds chart as well as the number rings. The next number identification is being stressed as well as the number before.

We are also practicing giving the students a series of numbers with missing numbers to fill in within the pattern.

The following skills will be taught in April: count and write 21 to 31, use logical reasoning to solve a problem, to count to 50 and 100 by ones, to count by tens, to make a table, to identify activities that happen first, next, and last, to identify parts of a calendar, and tell time to the hour.
