

Cell Phone Policy

Students are not permitted to use cell phones while under our supervision unless directed to do so by a staff member. If a parent finds it necessary for a child to bring a cell phone to school, the phone must be turned off and turned in to his or her homeroom teacher. The phone will be locked in cabinet during the day by the teacher. With this said, John F. Kennedy Catholic School is not responsible for lost or stolen phones.

If a student is found using a cell phone during school hours or has failed to provide the cell phone to the homeroom teacher, the cell phone will be confiscated and turned into the office.

1st Offense: Cell phones may be retrieved after 5 school days.

2nd Offense: Cell phones may be retrieved after 10 school days.

3rd Offense: Student will receive a 3-day in-school suspension. Cell phone will not be returned until the end of the year.

- Students are allowed to use personal devices in the morning and after care programs as long as devices are being used appropriately.
