The month of September is devoted to the Seven Sorrows of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The feast day is the 15<sup>th</sup>, following the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. She is usually depicted with seven swords piercing her Immaculate Heart.

Mary always leads us to Jesus. Console her and learn of what gives our Lord sorrow too by reflecting and meditating on the 7 Sorrows of the Blessed Virgin Mary:

1. The prophecy of Simeon (*Luke 2:25-35*)
2. The flight into Egypt (*Matthew 2:13-15*)
3. Loss of the Child Jesus for three days (*Luke 2:41-50*)
4. Mary meets Jesus on his way to Calvary (*Luke 23:27-31; John 19:17*)
5. Crucifixion and Death of Jesus (*John 19:25-30*)
6. The body of Jesus being taken from the Cross (*Psalms 130; Luke 23:50-54; John 19:31-37*)
7. The burial of Jesus (*Isaiah 53:8; Luke 23:50-56; John 19:38-42; Mark 15:40-47*)

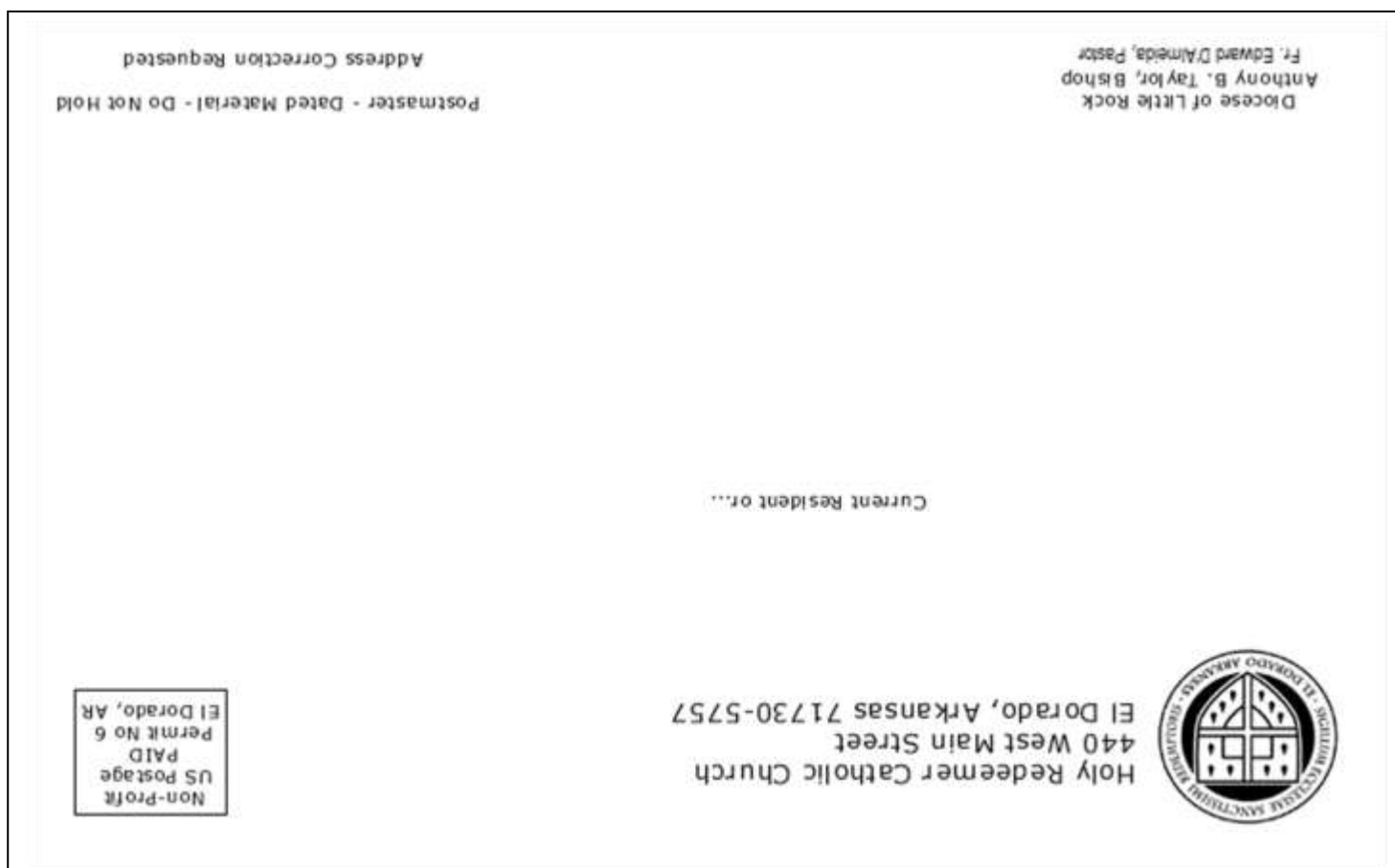
