- Spirit Catholic Radio (Spirit 102.7 - FM) presents Treasures of the Church—a relics exposition and healing ministry—at St. Joseph Catholic Church, Geneva, Ne. More than 150 sacred relics will be on display--some believed to be as old as 2,000 years. Among the treasures are relics of St. Therese of Lisieux, St. Francis of Assisi, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Thomas Aquinas and St. Faustina. In addition, there will be a piece of a veil believe to have belonged to Our Lady and one of the largest remaining pieces of the True Cross in the world. Presented by Fr.
