- Join us for a holy hour with exposition, adoration and community prayer for the intentions of the Lincoln Diocese priests sponsored by the Morning Star Chapter of Magnificat on Friday, June 21. Magnificat is a ministry to Catholic women whose fifth objective is to "Imitate Mary through spiritual adoption of priests and seminarians in prayer." All women are invited, even if you haven't attended a Magnificat Prayer Meal in the past. We will begin at 7 p.m. in the Chapel of John XXIII Center.
