2. Scroll down to find "eCatholic Live."
3. Click the play button and wait at least 1-2 minutes for the video to pull up. It may take less time or more, depending on your internet connection. If you're having trouble, refreshing the page may help.

When the Mass is finished, the video will be automatically archived and available for viewing at any time.

### PARISH ANNOUNCEMENTS

Palm branches can be picked up at St. Mary's beginning this weekend. Please be sure to grab them BEFORE Palm Sunday Mass as Fr. Zimmer can bless them during the April 4 & 5 Weekend Masses. Blessings given via livestream are STILL blessings, which will make these branches sacramentals :)

Distribution of Communion is available on Sundays from 11 a.m. to Noon in the CCD classrooms of St. Mary's. A signup is available on the homepage of the website. Please help spread the word to those who may not have internet access. Thank you!

Confession is available from 4:30-5:00 p.m. on Saturdays at St. Mary's. Certain guidelines must be followed during this time. Fr. Zimmer will be in the main church, and parishioners need to use the hall side doors. If there is a line, they need to keep social distancing and extend the line into the parish hall, not exceeding 10 people. There will be hand sanitizer at the doors to be used when entering. A person may confess behind Fr. Zimmer or go face to face.

An adoration sign-up is available on our website. Online sign-up is not required, but doing so will give us a better idea of how many people to expect. Again, only ten people can be in the church at one time.

Stations will be available via our website at 7 p.m. on Fridays.

The Altar Society meetings for both parishes have been canceled for April. Also, the bake sale scheduled for Friday, April 3<sup>rd</sup> at Brown's has been canceled.

Please assume that most parish / diocesan events that were previously published are either cancelled or postponed with details to be announced at a later time.

Please continue cleaning the churches if you are scheduled to do so at this time. Wiping all door handles is especially important. If you feel your health will be compromised by this task, please contact your Altar Society president immediately.
