PARISH ANNOUNCEMENTS

Sunday, May 3rd will be the last time for the Distribution of the Blessed Sacrament scheduled from 11 a.m. to Noon at St. Mary's. After then, parishioners are welcome to attend Mass to receive the Eucharist.

Beginning Monday, May 4th, the public can attend Mass. The obligation to attend Mass is still abrogated at this time. Hand sanitizer will be available at all entrances. Those living in the same household may sit together in the same pew but must be separated from other families by at least six feet. Please skip a pew between parishioners. St. Mary's hall will be available for overflow. The live stream service will be available for those in the hall and anyone at home. Communion will be distributed in a safe manner, which Fr. Zimmer will explain at Mass. The Sign of Peace will be omitted.

St. Mary's offers Adoration on Tuesdays from 6-7 p.m. Since the 10-person limit inside churches has been lifted, signing up is no longer required and will be removed from our website. Parishioners who attend Adoration are still expected to maintain social distancing.

Beginning May 9th, Confession will be offered as normal, with Fr. Zimmer in the confessional. Confession is offered at St. Mary's on Saturdays from 5-5:20 p.m. and Sundays from 8:20 to 8:50 a.m. Confession at St. Helena's is offered Sundays from 10:45-10:55 a.m.

First Communion at St. Mary's is tentatively set for Sunday, May 17th. Specific guidelines will be available in next week's bulletin.

All contributions that were collected since mid-March will be posted next weekend.
