Who We Are

Fruits of Mary is being established as a non-profit child care program located in the parish hall basement of St. Mary's in Sutton. Maintaining a 12:2 child to staff ratio, we will provide care for children six weeks to five years old (Pre-K). Our hours of operation will be Monday – Thursday 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. We welcome all faiths to our program, which will incorporate the teachings of the Catholic Church.

Our Mission

Fruits of Mary seeks to advance the pro-life efforts of St. Mary's Catholic Church by providing a safe and nurturing environment that instills a joyful love for Jesus and Mary.

Our Progress So Far

- We have hired Ashley Roth as the director, who will manage the day-to-day operation. She will be assisted by Tracy Galusha in the classroom. Both Ashley and Tracy have their degrees in education. Lindsay Anderson and Julie Haag are also helping with the overall development of the program.
- Our application to be a licensed Family Child Care Home II Program has been received by the Department of Health and Human Services of Nebraska and is currently under review.
- Our LB840 application to the City of Sutton has been submitted. We are waiting to hear back from the committee. If our request for this grant is approved, we have the potential of receiving 25% of our start-up costs. We are also applying for additional grants available through the State of Nebraska.
- Donations have been generously given to help with the start-up costs.
- In the coming weeks, a black steel fence will be installed, just north of the basement doors to enclose our outdoor play space to the east. Some landscaping will be moved to other parts of the property.

What We Still Need

- At least one part-time staff member is needed, especially for late afternoons, to make this program function. This position would be a great opportunity for a young person seeking a career involving children. It would also be great for the retired person seeking only a few hours a week.
- Substitutes for the full-time staff are needed. Substitutes count in the child to staff ratio and take on the responsibilities of the primary providers when they are absent, so some training is required.
- Volunteers do not count in the child to staff ratio, but another set of hands is always helpful!

Our Potential Opening Date

We could open any time between Wednesday, Sept. 8th (at the earliest) and Monday, Oct. 4th (hopefully, at the latest). No guarantees for the start date can be made until our license is approved.
