When you take a tag, please be sure to write the tag number and your name and phone number on one of the green sheets on a clipboard on the table right by the tree.

*This is essential so that we can keep track of the gifts and help you if you happen to misplace your tag.*



Because of Covid-19 this year and fewer people physically visiting JDW, there will be another way to receive an angel tree tag. On Sunday, November 22 around Noon, whatever tags have not yet been taken off the tree will be available for folks who are unable to get to JDW to take a tag off the tree.

Please specify if you prefer:

Please print the tag at home if you are able so you can tape it onto the outside of the bag. If you are unable to print the tag, please be sure to write the tag number on a piece of paper and securely tape it to your bag.

When you have purchased the gifts requested, please place the **UNWRAPPED** gifts in a plastic trash bag with a twist tie. Please make sure the Angel tag is securely taped to the **OUTSIDE** of the bag. All gifts need to be returned to the narthex

**BY 10 AM ON SUNDAY, DECEMBER 6.**

Help will be needed from 10 AM - Noon on Sunday, December 6  
sorting and organizing the gifts.

On Wednesday, December 9 around Noon, help will be needed to load up vehicles with the gifts and transport them down to the county fairgrounds.
