- + Join us for Stations, Soup and Study during Lent on Fridays at 6 PM. There will be a meatless carry in dinner in the social hall following the stations. Then we will have a short program based on the FORMED Lenten series. Stations of the Cross in Covington are on Wednesday's following the 7 PM Mass. There will be board games and cheese pizza available for kids.
