Bishop Michael Duca Appointed Bishop of the Diocese of Baton Rouge



In his tenth year as Bishop of Shreveport, our Holy Father Pope Francis has named Bishop Michael Duca the 6th Bishop of the Diocese of Baton Rouge. His installation as Bishop of Baton Rouge will take place on August 24, 2018, at 2:00 PM at the Cathedral in Baton Rouge. After Bishop Duca has taken his place in his new position, the College of Consultors of the Diocese of Shreveport, composed of the priests of the Presbyteral Council, will meet to choose from among the priests of the diocese, an administrator to manage the diocese until a new bishop is chosen.
