### Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults



RCIA is a spiritual journey into the Catholic faith. It is an exploration of Catholic teachings, traditions, and practices. Participants attend weekly sessions which begin in the fall each year. It is a process whereby adults become fully participating members of the church through a series of rites, which conclude at the Easter Vigil service in the spring. Each person is supported by sponsors and the prayers of the entire church. RCIA is for those who: 1) have not been baptized; 2) have been baptized in another faith and now wish to join the Catholic Church; or 3) have been baptized in the Catholic faith but have not received the sacraments of Confirmation and/or Eucharist.
