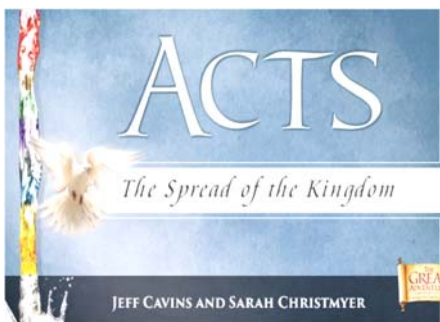
### Video Series
