

# St. Mary's CYO 2020 SPRING TENNIS REGISTRATION – OPEN TO ALL

Spring Tennis program for Girls and Boys Grades 3 – 5

The St. Mary's Spring Tennis Program is open to boys and girls in grades 3 – 5 who live in the St. Mary's parish boundary or live in adjoining parishes that do not have their own CYO Tennis program, including residents of Glen Head, Old Brookville, Greenvale, Roslyn, Roslyn Harbor, Roslyn Heights, Roslyn Estates and East Hills. Tennis team members will learn the fundamentals of tennis from United States Tennis Association trainers and qualified coaches. Team members will also have an opportunity to play in small tournaments against other parishes at locations throughout Nassau County. Practices are typically once per week based on the time availability of the coaches and trainers. Teams are co-ed for each grade. The program will run from Saturday, March 21<sup>st</sup> through May 9<sup>th</sup> (please note that practices may NOT occur due to religious holidays).

We want the children who participate to enjoy the program, and emphasize team over individual accomplishments, with the focus on learning the fundamentals of tennis.

### Program

The track program is a co-ed program given the ages of the children, and split by grades: 3,4 and 5. This program is run by volunteers and the only way to have continued success is for parents to assist and volunteer. It is also a great way to share in the overall experience as well as to support your children. WE NEED COACHES AND ASSISTANTS AT ALL LEVELS (no prior experience needed) for practices and tournaments. The USTA will provide training.

### Practices\*

Practices are usually held at least one time per week based on the time availability of the coaches/trainers and last about one hour\*. Children have very hectic schedules these days, and we know this, but we ask that every effort be made to have your children regularly attend practice. Improvement and success will only come with dedication and training.

Once the rosters are set up you will be notified of the time and location of your child's practices. Practices are expected to begin in late March, and are typically held at the St. Mary's School.\*
