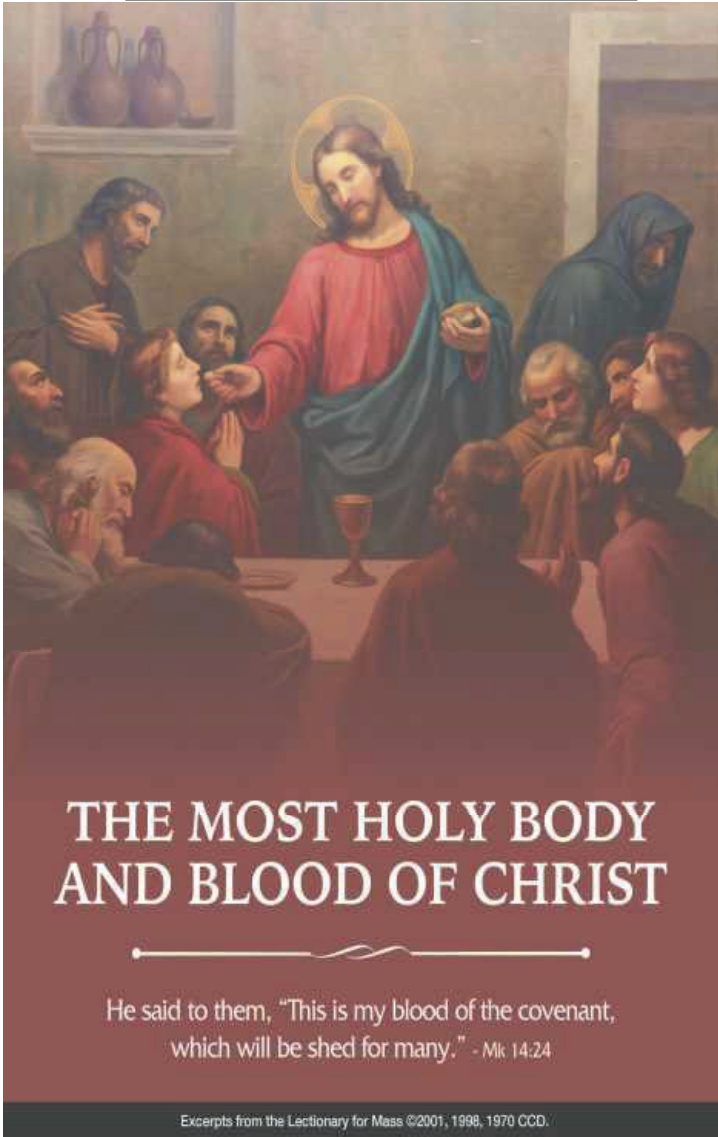

**Announcing Our New Music Director**

I am pleased to announce that Christ the King Parish has hired a new Director of Liturgical Music. He is Jonathan Bezdegian of Paxton. He will begin his work among us on the weekend of June 23 & 24. This announcement comes following an intensive search in recent months.

Several months ago, I assembled a search committee comprised of representatives of all three choirs: the Folk Group, the Festival Choir and the Youth Choir. The members were Melissa Boyle, Helen Foley, Paul Foley, Dick Freije, Elise Jacques, Bonnie McCrea, Kerri Melley, Neal Melley, Dave Ofarcik and Ginny Ryan. We entertained applications from the American Guild of Organists (both national and local chapters), the National Pastoral Musicians organization (both national and local chapters) and from advertising in local sources (*The Catholic Free Press* and diocesan websites). We interviewed finalists and each finalist engaged our three choral groups at special meetings. It was a wonderful and inclusive process.

Currently, Mr. Bezdegian is the music director and organist at St. Matthew Parish in Southborough (since 2012). He will complete his work there in the weeks ahead. On Saturday, June 9 he will receive his doctoral degree from the University of Washington in Seattle.

Mr. Bezdegian is a life-long parishioner of Our Lady of Czestochowa Parish. He is a graduate of St. Mary's High School in Worcester. He has studied at McGill University in Montreal and the Oberlin Conservatory of Music in Ohio. He has been an adjunct faculty member at Assumption College and is the Director of Liturgical Music at St. Peter-Marian High School and he will also continue in those roles.

We look forward to introducing Jonathan to our parish community in mid-June and know that you will welcome him.

At the same time (and I will write more on this in coming weeks) I am very grateful for the exemplary service of Peter Brockmann in these months following the untimely death of Dennis Ferrante. He has worked very hard with our music groups and has served us well. God bless you, Peter!

# CORPUS CHRISTI

Every morning I catch a few minutes of the early news on TV to see what's going on. Part of it's the weather report and since April they've been telling us how many days are left to July 4th. Every day they do this. So much for living "one day at a time!" So, I've had a lot of time to think about July 4th. It's 27 days away. It gets me thinking about what we can expect that day - all that eating.

But what would it be like if you go to someone's 4th of July party and you get there and they say, "Now we're all going to stand and sing the National Anthem - and then go home"? "No," you'd say. "Where are the hot dogs? Where's the meal here?" We don't go to somebody's wedding and they say, "Okay, here's the toast, now go home." No, we eat. We don't go to funerals and hear someone say, "There's the body, here's the Mass - now go home." We don't do that in life, do we? No, eating is a part of every important human gathering.

As the nation celebrates its freedom - we eat. Somebody gets married - we eat. Somebody dies - we eat. And, when someone says, "Let's go to church" - we eat.

That's what we do here at Mass. We don't just listen. We don't just sing - though both are important. We eat! And what we eat is the Body and Blood of Christ - the same Christ who gave his apostles a meal on the last night of his life - and said, "Continue to do this. Remember me this way."

This is the meal we celebrate on *Corpus Christi* ("the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ") - and every Sunday and every day. It is the greatest meal we can possibly enjoy.

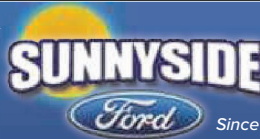

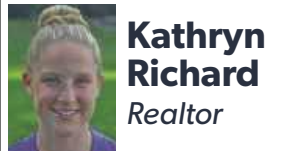
