

Saint Presentation

In order to better understand the Communion of Saints you are being Confirmed into, and in order to build a relationship with those close to God, you will be researching a Patron Saint. This may be presented through a variety of means, including but not limited to: power point, poster, time line, act/dress-up the part, etc..

It is encouraged in the Diocese of Kalamazoo for you to choose a saint's name to take on at Confirmation. This practice coincides with the many saints in the scriptures whose names were honored as they took on greater missions for God.

1. Saint's name, years of birth and death and an image of them.
2. What are they the Patron Saint of and what is the date?
3. Summary of the Saint's life in the style of an obituary with the most important facts about the person. Including where they lived, what their major accomplishments were, and important dates in their life.
4. Explain why this person is held up as an example to others. What attitudes and values influenced them? How does this inspire you personally?
5. Choose one of the following...
 - A. Choose one of the eight Beatitudes that most reflects this person's life. This can be a collage of images or symbols that represent how they lived the beatitude. You may draw or use at least five images. Make sure you state which Beatitude is being used.
 - B. Write a prayer to God or to the Saint. The prayer should reflect the spirit and values of the person.
 - C. Write a poem reflecting the spirit and values of the person. Any poetic format may be used and should be at least 2 or 3 stanzas.
