



Building a Legacy: On the Rock Facility Project Update 8-9-20



The move to the Parish Center is complete. This will be our 'new home' for the next many months while the Church is being renovated and the Gathering Space is being built. There are still a few tweaks being made, but the Parish Hall and the Saint Kateri Room both have a nice sacred feel. Much thanks and appreciation to the Parish Staff for their effort with this transition.

The Construction Project will last into March of next year. It is important to the Construction Committee that we keep you informed and allow you to walk with us every step of the way through this journey. The 'Facility Project Update' will be a regular feature in this space throughout the project. Watch for the update on **what is happening** and **what is planned over the next few weeks**. At times we will include pictures with the update. We are also planning an 'Exhibition' in the hallway of the Parish Center around mid-September. The final drawings and information will be on display.

So, what has been happening so far?

- ◆ **The Staff**, plus a few others, finished emptying out the Church, storing most items in the classrooms of the Parish Center
- ◆ **OAK Construction, the Team managing the project for St. Peter**, took over the site on July 30 and have completed the following:
 - ◇ **Mobilization:** Fenced off the site, job trailer on-site
 - ◇ **Make-safe:** Disconnect plumbing, mechanical and electrical systems as required to safely perform demolition [with apologies to Father Fabio as some systems also impacted the Rectory]
 - ◇ **Salvage:** remove and put into storage items to be re-used such as **the crucifix; confessional wood and glass, and certain stained and etched windows**
 - ◇ **Temporary protection:** the stained and etched windows that will remain as part of the Church have all been covered with plywood to prevent damage during demolition
 - ◇ The **demolition** of the interior of the Church is well underway [see picture]
 - ◇ **Asbestos abatement** has started and will occur for the next couple of weeks; abatement is a slow process and stops all other activity
- ◆ And **when abatement concludes** late this month, the real fun will begin
