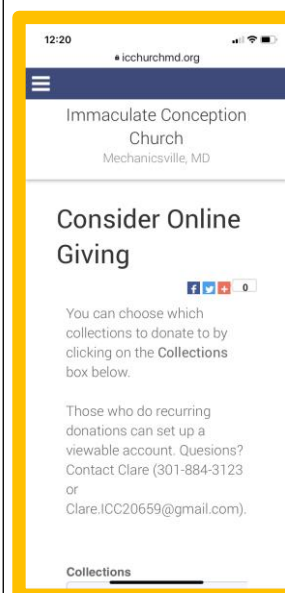

A photographer will be present. Additional information about pictures will be provided later. Seating will be limited because of social distancing regulations. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. We will be live streaming the Mass on YouTube. Also, you will be able to listen/tune in on the radio in the parking area of church on 98.1 FM.

CONFIRMATION PARENTS, SPONSORS, AND KIDS – Please make sure your calendars are up to date for attending CONFIRMATION and PRACTICE. PRACTICE date is **Sunday, September 20th at 6:30 pm** in the Church, and CONFIRMATION is **Monday, September 21st at 7:00 pm**. Gowns will be distributed at PRACTICE and dropped off after CONFIRMATION. Please make sure you wear something proper underneath your gowns.

Because of social distancing regulations, we are going to have to limit 2 people per family, your child plus the child's sponsor. We will be live streaming the Mass on YouTube. Also, you will be able to listen/tune in on the radio in the parking area of church on 98.1 FM.
