By now, most of you know that the Governor extended the “Stay at home, Stay Safe” order to June 12. (Which happens to be my 50th birthday. Hmm... coincidence or not?)

Anyway, Bishop Bradley has announced that parishes in the diocese will still resume public Masses as of May 27. As I said in my last video, there are a number of protocols that we must follow. I’ll be posting those as the week goes on.

So, tomorrow’s Mass will be online at 11:00 AM as we have been doing. On May 27 (this Thursday) we will return to our usual daily Mass schedule (with rules we must follow). Next weekend, May 30 and 31, we will celebrate the usual vigil Mass on Saturday at 4:30 PM. And then on Sunday, May 31 which is the Solemnity of Pentecost, we will celebrate Mass at 9:00 AM and 11:30 AM. (again, following guidelines).

We will continue to livestream the Sunday Mass for the foreseeable future. The 9:00 AM Mass on Sunday will be the one online beginning May 31.
