Gun Violence Action Ideas**

Many of us feel helpless in the wake of gun violence. Regardless of your views, here are some ideas from our Social Justice Team on ways to respond:

- Visit an organization that works with victims.
- Ask your religious leaders to preach on the issue.
- Display pins and stickers that express your point of view.
- Organize a petition drive.
- Arrange for a speaker or educational program.
- Participate in marches, pilgrimages, vigils, and rallies.
- Boycott retailers that don't reflect your values.
- Sign up for text alerts regarding pending legislation.
- Meet or write elected officials to express your opinion.
- Use the economic power of purchases and investments.
- Write to newspapers, alumni newsletters, etc.
- Provide time, talent, or financial support to organizations that are working for change.
- Investigate how your retirement funds are invested.
- Attend stock holder meetings and express your views.
- Organize a prayer service.
