LENT 2021**

**Lent 2021 will begin on
Wednesday, February 17 and ends on
Saturday, April 3**

GUIDELINES FOR FAST AND ABSTINENCE

Lenten fast and abstinence regulations for the Diocese of Worcester are as follows:

- Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics fourteen (14) years of age and older on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent.
- Fasting is to be observed by all Catholics who are eighteen (18) years of age but not yet fifty- nine (59) years of age on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
- Those who are bound to fast may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary, to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed Lenten penitential practices.

ASH WEDNESDAY The Order for the Blessing and Distribution of Ashes normally takes place during the celebration of Mass. However, when circumstances require, the blessing and distribution of ashes may take place during a Liturgy of the Word or other appropriate liturgical service. However, ashes may never be distributed apart from a liturgical service. Extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion and other lay persons may assist in the imposition of ashes when there is a true pastoral need.

Mandated COVID-19 precautions should be carefully observed.

La Cuaresma 2021 Comenzará Miércoles 17 De febrero Y Finaliza El Sábado 3 De abril DIRECTRICES PARA EL RÁPIDO Y LA ABSTINENCIA

Las regulaciones de ayuno y abstinencia de Cuaresma para la Diócesis de Worcester son las siguientes:

- Todos los católicos mayores de catorce (14) años de edad deben observar la abstinencia de carne el Miércoles de Ceniza, el Viernes Santo y todos los viernes de Cuaresma,
- Todos los católicos que tengan dieciocho (18) años de edad, pero que aún no hayan cumplido los cincuenta y nueve (59) años, deben observar el ayuno el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo.
- Aquellos que están obligados a ayunar pueden tomar solo una comida completa. Se permiten dos comidas más pequeñas si es necesario, para mantener la fuerza según las necesidades, pero no se permite comer alimentos sólidos entre comidas. Los católicos no deben excusarse a la ligera de estas prácticas penitenciales de Cuaresma prescritas.

MIERCOLES DE CENIZAS

La Orden para la Bendición y Distribución de Cenizas normalmente se lleva a cabo durante la celebración de la Misa. Sin embargo, cuando las circunstancias lo requieran, la bendición y distribución de las cenizas puede tener lugar durante una Liturgia de la Palabra u otro servicio litúrgico apropiado. Sin embargo, las cenizas nunca pueden distribuirse fuera de un servicio litúrgico. Los ministros extraordinarios de la Sagrada Comunión y otros laicos pueden ayudar en la imposición de cenizas cuando existe una verdadera necesidad pastoral.

Se deben observar cuidadosamente las precauciones obligatorias de COVID-19.
