Jesus did not seek temptation. The Holy Spirit led Him into the desert to be tempted. If we encounter

temptation in that place where the Spirit of God leads us, we must be firmly confident that God will strengthen us against these temptations no matter how strong they may be. Yet, no matter how holy and generous we may think ourselves to be, we must never trust in our own strength or courage, and go out and seek temptation, thinking we can confound it. Nonetheless, we must prepare ourselves to rise above temptation. Like Jesus, we must arm ourselves with the truth of God. This truth is nothing other than faith, which shields us from temptations. When we say, "I believe" in God the Almighty, we place our trust in God's power, not in our own strength.

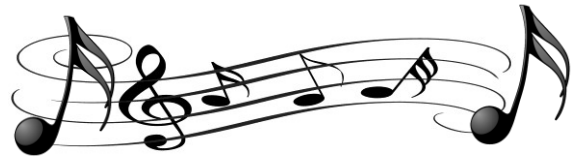
As soon as you are conscious of being tempted, follow the example of children when they see a wolf or bear out in the country. They immediately run to the arms of their parents or call to them for help and protection. If the temptation continues, embrace the Holy Cross, and look at our Lord. If we do not approach them, they will do us no harm, even if they try to frighten us by barking at us.

Fasting is to be observed by all Catholic who are 18 years of age but not yet 59 years of age on Good Friday.

A veces, cuando nos enfrentamos a una tentación, al principio, nos sentimos heridos por alguna emoción atribulada. Por desgracia, podríamos pensar que es casi imposible servir a Dios en santidad. No te preocupes por un miedo tan vano. Armados con la verdad de la Palabra de Dios, Dios nos fortalecerá y nos dará la gracia para perseverar y hacer lo que se requiere para la gloria de Dios y nuestro propio bienestar y felicidad.
