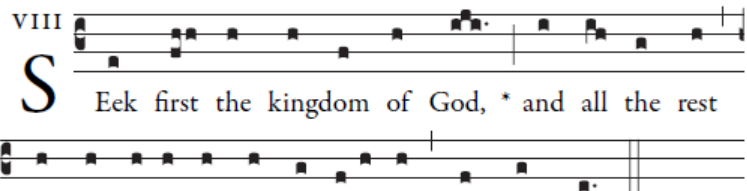

#### ASH WEDNESDAY AND LENT
