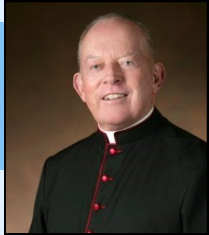

Parish Family of St. Paul Cathedral

We, your priests & parish staff are happy you are with us for this first step in returning to a semblance of “normal”. Your presence here is most encouraging.

1. Masses are offered this weekend & following weekends on Saturday at 5:30PM, 7:00PM (Spanish) and on Sundays at 7:00AM, 9:00AM, 11:00AM, 1:00PM (Spanish) & 7:00PM LifeTeen. Remember the obligation to participate in Sunday Mass does not bind at this time of the virus crisis and if you are sick or infirm disabled in any way, please stay home for the time being. We must wear masks for any religious gathering and keep this social distancing of 6 feet from others.
2. Reconciliation (Confessions) will resume next Saturday at 4:00PM, entering from the courtyard by the fountain (line ups outside by the fountain. **NO INSIDE WAITING!** We will celebrate the sacrament in the Chapel & Sacristy. Please be considerate of elderly or infirm.
3. Weekday Masses will resume a week from Monday (outside) by the fountain courtyard, presently at 11:00AM until further notice. Masks must be worn!
4. Communion at weekend Masses will be distributed after Mass is ended only in the hand. Approach the minister with a mask on, receive the host, step aside, raise your mask and receive the host.

I don't like these restrictions any more than you do, but we need to observe them at this time for the love & care of one another.

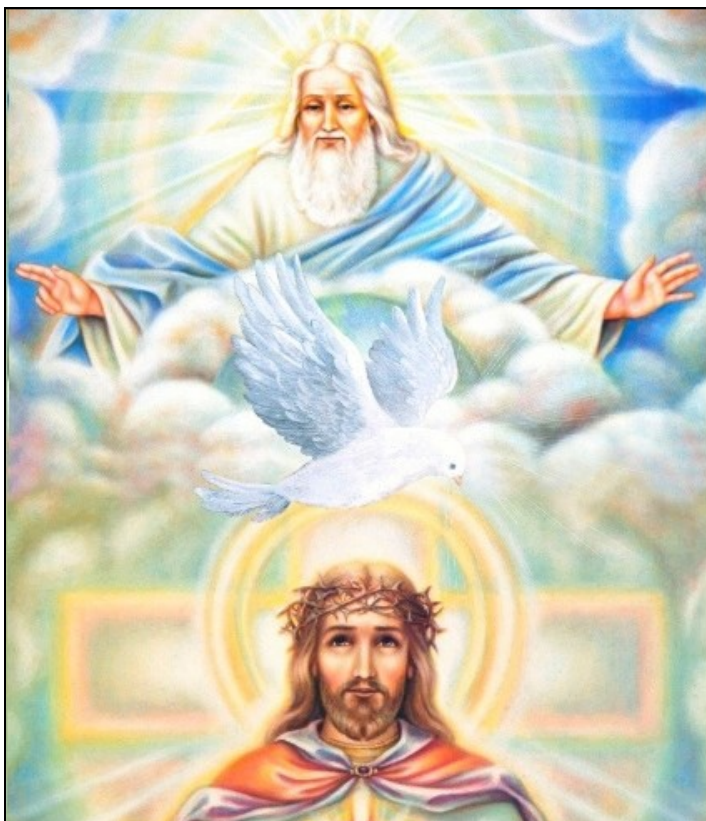
