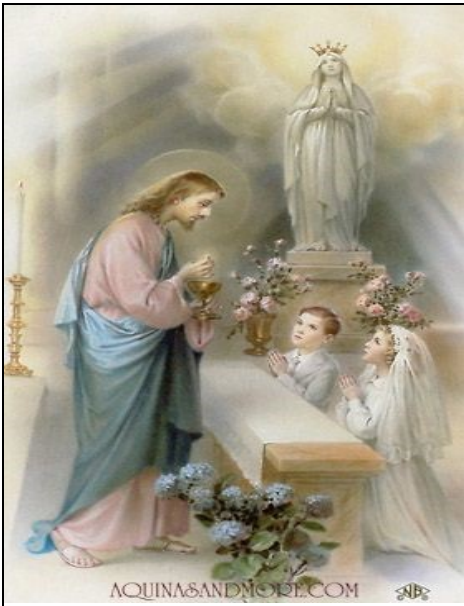

### History of the Ascension

The observance of this feast is of great antiquity. Eusebius seems to hint at the celebration of it in the 4th century. At the beginning of the 5th century, St. Augustine says that it is of Apostolic origin, and he speaks of it in a way that shows it was the universal observance of the Church long before his time.

The *Pilgrimage of Aetheria* speaks of the vigil of this feast and of the feast itself, as they were kept in the church built over the grotto in Bethlehem in which Christ was born.

Some historians believe that in the early church the Ascension was celebrated along with Pentecost. Representations of the mystery are found in frescoes dating as early as the 5th century. Most Christian faiths celebrate the Feast of the Ascension.

### Divine Mercy Reflections from St. Faustina's Diary

Jesus said: I remind you, My daughter, that as often as you hear the clock strike the third hour, immerse yourself completely in My mercy, adoring and glorifying it; invoke its omnipotence for the whole world, and particularly for poor sinners; for at that moment mercy was opened wide for every soul. In this hour you can obtain everything for yourself and for others for the asking; it was the hour of grace for the whole world. Mercy triumphed over justice. (*Diary*, 1572)
