The Jubilee Museum

The Jubilee Museum has been recognized by the Vatican as the largest collection of diversified Catholic art in the U.S. Established in 1998 by Fr. Kevin Lutz, its purpose is to preserve the Catholic mind and memory as it is represented in art. The museum embraces art that tells the story of Christ, Mary, the saints, and the history of the Catholic Church.

Currently their featured exhibit is **The Lego Vatican**. Artist Fr. Simon has been a Roman Catholic priest for 27 years. Setup of the model takes up to two days, with three people working on the structure's 25 different sections. The Piazza has over 44,000 cobblestones sitting atop 12,000 tan tiles. There are over 6,000 round bricks that make up the columns of the Colonnade. The model is worth \$10,000 in LEGO® bricks and took over 10 months to build.

June is the month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

Since the 16th century Catholic piety has assigned entire months to special devotions. The month of June is set apart for devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. *"From among all the proofs of the infinite goodness of our Savior none stands out more prominently than the fact that, as the love of the faithful grew cold, He, Divine Love Itself, gave Himself to us to be honored by a very special devotion and that the rich treasury of the Church was thrown wide open in the interests of that devotion."* *"These words of Pope Pius XI refer to the Sacred Heart Devotion, which in its present form dates from the revelations given to Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque in 1673-75."*

Hunger in our Area

21 million children in the US receive free meals at school but during the summer months only 2 million children receive free meals. In Ohio 1 in 5 children are hungry.

Last fall a Frazeyburg child told a friend that he was glad it was Monday because that meant he'd have food—that over the weekend the only thing he'd had to eat was left over Halloween candy.

Children are hungry in our own community. Please be generous with your donations to our food ministry.

If you want to give to the Frazeyburg Food Pantry you may deliver your donations there on Mondays from 10-12 noon and 4-6 pm. The food pantry is located in the old school.

Donations made at Mass are usually given to the food pantry in Dresden but if we have a surplus of donations we will take them to the Frazeyburg Food Pantry as well.

Our parish goal is to donate one food item per week or four items per month.

Prayer to the Sacred Heart

Devotion to the Sacred Heart was the characteristic note of the piety of Saint Gertrude the Great (1256-1302), Benedictine nun and renowned mystic. She was, in fact, the first great exponent of devotion to the Sacred Heart. In our efforts to honor the Heart of Jesus we have this prayer as a model for our own:

Hail! O Sacred Heart of Jesus, living and quickening source of eternal life, infinite treasure of the Divinity, and burning furnace of divine love. Thou art my refuge and my sanctuary, O my amiable Savior. Consume my heart with that burning fire with which Thine is ever inflamed. Pour down on my soul those graces which flow from Thy love, and let my heart be so united with Thine, that our wills may be one, and mine in all things be conformed to Thine. May Thy divine will be equally the standard and rule of all my desires and of all my actions.
