## Paul wrote 13 books of the Bible

From the moment he was saved, he began preaching about Jesus. Over the next several years, Paul traveled extensively, planting churches wherever he went.

When not with those churches, he still carried the responsibility for them in his heart, like a father for his children. Much of the New Testament is made up of his letters to some of those churches.

The following is a breakdown of the letters Paul wrote and the possible timeframes in which he wrote them: Galatians (AD 47), 1 & 2 Thessalonians (AD 49–51), 1 & 2 Corinthians and Romans (AD 52–56), Ephesians, Philemon, Colossians, and Philippians (AD 60–62, during Paul's first Roman imprisonment), 1 Timothy & Titus (AD 62), 2 Timothy (AD 63–64, during Paul's second Roman imprisonment).

Although Paul penned or dictated these letters, he makes it clear that he is speaking under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit. The other apostles, as well as the early church, accepted these letters as words from God.

## In the third week of the Bishop Robert Barron series he said the Mass is where we find Christ most fully and intensely.

The Great Story, the story that we belong to, is the Mass and the person who is speaking is Christ.

The Liturgy of the Word is an intense encounter with the Lord. The Holy Spirit interprets as we listen to the Gospels and Epistles.

The first reading is from the Old Testament. The Psalm speaks back to God reflecting the first reading.

The second reading is from the New Testament and reminds us of the Apostles' traditions. To understand the New Testament you have to read the Old Testament. We sit during the readings but we are attentively listening.

The Gospels are the heart of all the Scriptures because they are our principal source for the life and teaching of Jesus. The Gospel is so sacred that it can only be read by an ordained individual such as a priest or deacon.
