What is the difference between a church being Blessed and a church being Consecrated?

At a consecration the ceremonies are
more solemn and elaborate than at a
blessing. The ordinary minister of a
consecration is a bishop, while the or-
dinary minister of a blessing is a priest.

At every consecration the holy oils are
used; at a blessing customarily only
holy water.

The new state to which consecration
elevates persons or things is perma-
nent, and the rite can never be repeat-
ed, which is not the case at a blessing;
the graces attached to consecration
are more numerous and efficacious
than those attached to a
blessing.
