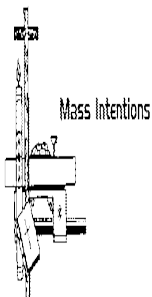
## PRAYER FOR OUR MILITARY

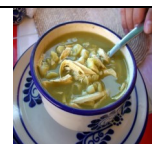
