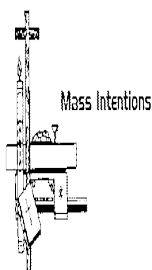
Bulletin submission deadline for the November 25 bulletin is November 14. Submissions can be either put in the collection basket or emailed to sheimer@localnet.com.
