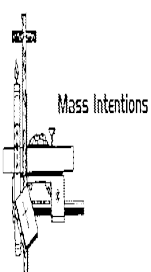
### PRAYER FOR OUR MILITARY

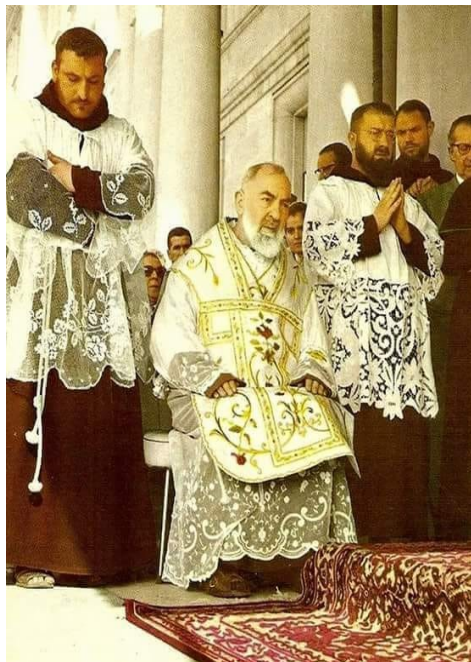
