Trinity Sunday

also known as Holy Trinity Sunday, celebrated a week after Pentecost Sunday, is in honor of the most fundamental of Christian beliefs—belief in the Holy Trinity.

We can never fully understand the mystery of the Trinity, but we can sum it up in the following formula: God is three Persons in one Nature. The three Persons of God—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit—are all equally God, and they cannot be divided.

To stress the doctrine of the Trinity, Fathers of the Church composed prayers and hymns that were recited in the Church's liturgies and on Sundays as part of the Divine Office.

Eventually, a special version of this office began to be celebrated on the Sunday after Pentecost and it was called Trinity Sunday. The celebration of Trinity Sunday was made universal by Pope John XXII (1316-34).

Trinity Sunday is celebrated in all the Western liturgical churches: Roman Catholic, Anglican, Lutheran, Presbyterian, Methodist and Baptist.

Pilgrimage to EWTN 'Eternal Word Television Network' and The Shrine of the Blessed Sacrament and Our Lady of the Angels Monastery

St Nicholas Church is researching a pilgrimage to Alabama to EWTN and the Shrine of the Blessed Sacrament. If you are interested in making a pilgrimage, please call 740-453-7141.

They are looking at a 4 day - 3night pilgrimage, possibly September 16 - through 19. If they can fill a 50 passenger bus, the cost would be approximately \$370 per person (4 per room) \$500 per person (2 in room). The price includes a seat on the bus, hotel room, breakfast at hotel and lunch each day.

EWTN was founded by Mother Angelica in 1981 and today is the largest media network in the world. In 1999 the Shrine and Monastery were dedicated in Hanceville, AL, about 60 miles from EWTN.

A pilgrimage to the Shrine of the Most Blessed Sacrament provides a place for prayer and quiet contemplation - pilgrims may attend Holy Mass, silently join the Nuns as they pray the Liturgy of the Hours throughout the day and spend time in private Adoration. The Shrine is notable for its gilt interior, solemn atmosphere, and 7.5 ft. monstrance.

The Feast of Corpus Christi Procession

June 23, next Sunday, immediately after Mass at St. Ann, refreshments and reflection will follow

We will stop at four temporary altars for prayer along a one block route.

The Corpus Christi procession is not a walking to the Lord, to the Eucharistic celebration; it is a walking with the Lord; it is itself an element of the Eucharistic celebration, one dimension of the Eucharistic event. The Lord who has become our bread is thus showing us the way, He leads us.

The canopy serves a dual purpose. It protects the Blessed Sacrament during the procession. It provides a "scared space" that is reserved for the priest carrying the monstrance.

It also protects the monstrance against anything that might fall on it, including light rain.

Secondarily, the faithful at the back of the procession can locate the Blessed Sacrament at the head of the procession more easily.

The procession is a visible sign of our faith. **Please plan to attend.**
