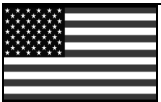

Enthronement of the Sacred Heart Of Jesus this Sunday immediately following Mass at St. Ann

Father Franks will Enthronement the Sacred Heart of Jesus and Consecrate the Parish to His Sacred Heart on August 4th immediately following Mass at St. Ann. There will be a brief reception in the rectory afterwards.

In 1672 our Lord appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque. Over a series of visits, Our Lord revealed to St. Margaret Mary the importance of devotion to His Sacred Heart. He asked that His heart, wounded on the cross and continually wounded by ingratitude of men for his sacrifice for them, be venerated and adored as an embodiment of His Divine mercy and love. Our Lord revealed that wherever the image of His sacred Heart was exposed and given special honor, great blessings and graces would abound.

One way to accomplish this goal is to do formal enthronement of the Sacred Heart in the home or parish. The Enthronement is the dedication of a person or parish to the Divine Heart of Jesus, to live in union with Him by love, grace and obedience to His Commandments.

The Enthronement brings countless graces and blessings, as enumerated in the 12 Promises of the Sacred Heart of Jesus made to St. Margaret Mary. For those who have a true devotion to His Sacred Heart the promises are:

1. I will give them all the graces necessary in their state of life.
2. I will establish peace in their homes.
3. I will comfort them in all their afflictions.
4. I will secure refuge during their life, and above all, in death.
5. I will bestow abundant blessings upon all their undertakings.
6. Sinners will find in my Heart of source and infinite ocean of mercy.
7. Lukewarm souls will become fervent.
8. Fervent souls will quickly mount to high perfection.
9. I will bless every place in which an image of my Heart is exposed and honored.
10. I will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts.
11. Those who shall promote this devotion shall have their names written in My Heart.
12. I promise you in the excessive mercy of my Heart that my all-powerful love will grant to all those who receive Holy Communion on the First Friday in nine consecutive months the grace of final perseverance; they shall not die in my disgrace, nor without receiving their sacraments. My divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment.
