Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

A doctrine is an official teaching of the Church. A dogma is an infallible teaching of the Church. All dogmas are doctrines, but the reverse is not necessarily true.

The dogma of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary is this: at the end of her life, Mary was taken body and soul into heaven.

The Assumption was declared dogma relatively recently by Pope Pius XII in 1950 but it is a very old feast of the church. Homilies on the Assumption going back to the sixth century have been found and the feast has been celebrated universally by the sixth century.

The feast of the Assumption is considered the foremost feast of the Blessed Virgin Mary. It is celebrated on August 15.
