The Need for YCP by Bishop Brennan

Over 1,600 American Catholics leave the Church every single day; 93% are below the age of 35.

The Columbus chapter of Young Catholic Professionals (YCP) is the largest young adult organization in the Diocese of Columbus and is targeting the demographic of 21-39 year olds to create and build a Catholic community in Central Ohio to lay the foundation for the future of our church. While it has only been in existence one year, YCP has engaged thousands of young adults in our community. YCP hosted the largest event in diocesan history with almost 400 young adults in attendance. In addition about 100 young adults attend their monthly meetings.

With over 1,600 Catholics leaving the Church daily in the US, a desperate call is needed to stop this exodus. All ministries within Catholicism depend on the Church having enough members to support the work we do and with so many people leaving, our work is threatened.

Therefore, Bishop Brennan is hosting a fundraiser to support this incredible, effective organization. YCP is in need of financial assistance. This event will allow attendees to meet the founding young adults of YCP Columbus as well as Bishop Brennan.
