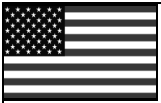

Divine Mercy Reflections from St. Faustina's Diary

Jesus said:

I know, My daughter, that you understand it and that you do everything within your power. But write this for the many souls who are often worried because they do not have the material means with which to carry out an act of mercy. Yet spiritual mercy, which requires neither permissions nor storehouses, is much more meritorious and is within the grasp of every soul. If a soul does not exercise mercy somehow or other, it will not obtain My mercy on the day of judgment (Diary, 1317)

Jesus said:

Pure love gives the soul strength at the very moment of dying. When I was dying on the cross, I was not thinking about Myself, but about poor sinners, and I prayed for them to My Father (Diary, 324).

Saint of the Day, 16 February, Blessed Bernard Scammacca (1430-1487) He was born in 1430 to upper-class and pious parents. He spent his adolescence as a wild and dissolute man during which time he received a severe leg wound in a duel. His convalescence provided him with adequate time to reflect on the course his life had taken. This made him realize that he was heading in the wrong direction and needed urgent changes. His healing renewed his links to his faith; he approached the Order of Preachers in 1452 in Catania and begged to be admitted to their order.

Bl Bernard became known for his range of charitable works and for his life of repentance for the life he had led. He fostered a particular devotion to the Passion of Christ, which sometimes led him into ecstasies. He founded a hospital for the poor, which still exists. He had the gift of being a prophet and used that gift to warn others to change their lives.
