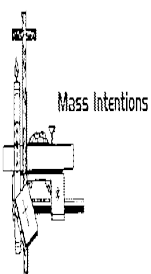

The Catholic Church commemorates Anna as a saint, with her feast day being celebrated on February 3. She is also often honored during the season of Advent.
