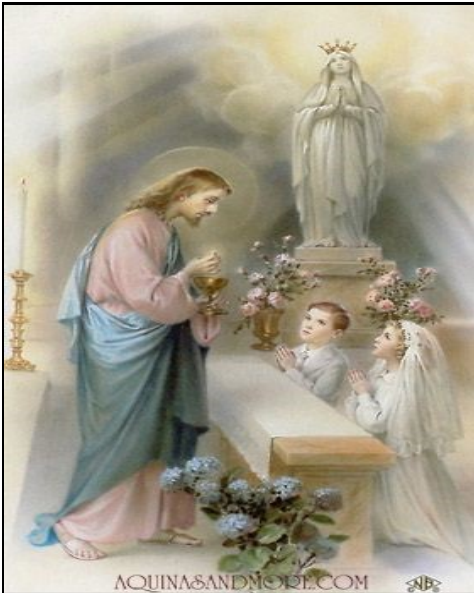

This has been changed to a **virtual** event only and is available on the parish You tube channel December 6 and beyond.

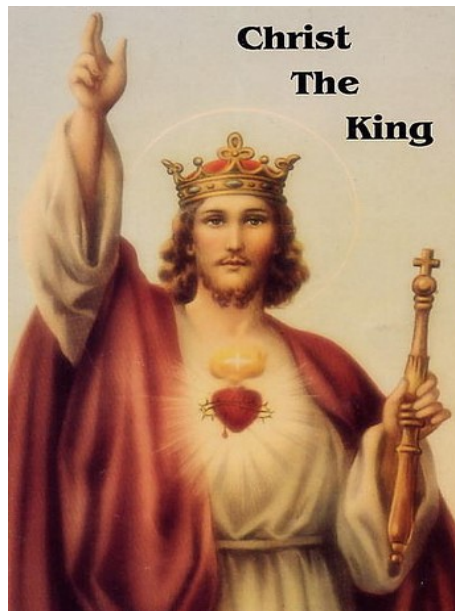

Today is The Feast of Christ the King

It was established by Pope Pius XI in 1925 as an antidote to secularism, a way of life which leaves God out of man's thinking and living as if God did not exist.

Today's Mass establishes the titles for Christ's royalty over men:

- 1) Christ is God, the Creator of the universe and hence wields a supreme power over all things; "All things were created by Him";
- 2) Christ is our Redeemer, He purchased us by His precious Blood, and made us His property and possession;
- 3) Christ is Head of the Church, "holding in all things the primacy";
- 4) God bestowed upon Christ the nations of the world as His special possession and dominion.

Today's Mass also describes the qualities of Christ's kingdom: "supreme, universal, eternal and spiritual".

November is dedicated to the Holy Souls in Purgatory

St. Stanislaus Papczynski (1631-1701) the Founder of the Marian Fathers of the Immaculate Conception, had a deep devotion for the Holy Souls in Purgatory that has since become integrated into the lives of each and every Marian priest and brother.
