

Instructions abound on youtube and pinterest to make an Advent wreath.

**How to Make an Advent Wreath** Buy a standard wreath frame, fashion one yourself out of heavy-gauge wire, or arrange your evergreen on a tray, mantel or windowsill. Gather candles and greenery. Optional items are bows, pinecones, etc. Poke your evergreen into your wreath or use hot glue. Add the optional items by poking them into the wreath, using hot glue or tying them to your greenery. Small bows may be placed around your wreath or a one large one can be used. Fire and drying branches don't mix (or, rather, they mix too well). If you notice that some branches have dried, remove them and replace them with fresh ones.

Now it's time to bless your Advent wreath. Find a blessing on line or check in next week's bulletin.
