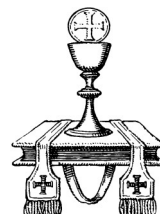

Highlights from June:

Sister Mary Ignatia Gavin was instrumental in founding and developing Alcoholics Anonymous and Al-Anon. Sister Ignatia realized that persons with alcoholism needed a healing beyond what medicine could provide. Along with co-founders, Dr. Bob Smith and Bill Wilson, Sister tried to treat alcoholics from both a medical and pastoral standpoint, then an uncharted field. She worked with Dr. Bob to help admit alcoholics into St. Thomas Hospital in Akron, Ohio, starting in 1939 and surmounted obstacles to personally care for thousands of alcoholics over the next several decades, both in Akron and later in Cleveland. Ignatia had a great devotion to the spiritual teachings of St. Ignatius Loyola, founder of the Jesuits, particularly his notion of "love through action." She found a strong parallel between the saint's writings and AA's Twelve Steps. Sister Ignatia chose to keep her work anonymous, giving credit to God and the sisters of her community. Beloved by all who were associated with or helped by her, she was commonly referred to as the "Angel of Alcoholics Anonymous." Over 3000 people attended her funeral.
