### America Needs Fatima Rosary Rally

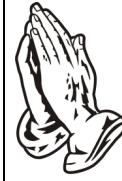
The annual public Rosary Rally will celebrate our Blessed Mother's apparitions with the three children in Fatima, Portugal.

Additionally, please also let me know when it appears somebody is down to their final days so I can anoint them again.

### ***The Holy Rosary***
