### Tidbit on St. Agatha

St. Agatha (of Sicily) was one of the virgin martyrs of the Church, born in 231 AD and died in 251 AD. Agatha became a conse-  
crated virgin at an early age and chose to dedicate herself wholly to Jesus and the Church in a life of prayer and service. A man of high diplomatic ranking, Quintianus, was attracted to Agatha and thought he could force her to marry him. But Agatha re-  
fused his proposal. Quintianus pursued a number of extremely cruel and abusive actions to-  
ward Agatha. Through all of this, Agatha endured and persisted with her faith with a sense of cheer and dedication to the Lord. After enduring many pain-  
ful tortures, Agatha died in pris-  
on. There is a major festival in Catania every year in her honor and memory. St. Agatha's feast day is February 5. She is the patron saint of rape victims and victims of domestic violence, breast cancer patients and nurs-  
es, fires and earthquakes, among many others.
